Shooting is to be regulated in accordance with the GNAS Rules of Shooting.

This competition is open only to individuals affiliated to GNAS / ArcheryGB or a FITA member association. Entrants must produce their registration card or proof of membership for inspection at Registration.

Entrants may use any GNAS Target Bow Styles except for Crossbows.

The venue is a multi-purpose sports field. **All-Carbon arrow shafts are strongly discouraged.** All-carbon arrow owners shall be responsible for recovering all lost arrows before the field is vacated and shall be responsible for paying any search or recovery costs.

Awards Senior Awards are open to all Adult Entrants. Sussex Junior Championship Awards are open to members of the Sussex County Archery Association. Visitor Medals will be awarded to class winners who are not members of SCAA.

Awards will be given to Ladies and Gentlemen according to Round and Bowstyle. The number of awards will depend on the number of entrants in the class. At least one award will be given for every class that has any entrants. In order to be eligible for SCAA awards, Adult Archers must shoot the Adult Round for their Gender.

To be eligible for Junior Awards, Junior entrants must shoot a Round that qualifies for GNAS National Records in their age group. The minimum qualifying rounds by age group are...

Refreshments Hot and cold drinks, and barbecued or fried food will be available on the tournament field.

Dogs are not permitted within the school grounds. Smoking is not permitted within the school grounds. No naked flame burners will be permitted inside or near competitors' tents

Shooting Order Shooting will be in accordance with rule 304.f (ii). i.e. Method 2.

Up to four archers per target. At all distances shooting will be in two details of six arrows (four minutes allowed).

Shooting to be controlled by visual display and audible signals.

As the Rounds are Archery GB Metric Rounds, six sighter arrows only will be allowed at commencement of shooting.

The GNAS Bouncer Rule will apply, arrow holes need not be marked.

Bosses All target bosses are 'Eleven' foam slabs.

Faces Adults shooting Short Metric round: Longbow and Barebow Archers and Recurves who prefer will shoot at a single 80cm Face; Compound Archers and Recurve Archers who choose to will shoot at individual 6-zone faces.

Junior Metric 1-5 rounds: All bow types will shoot on full size 80cm faces.

Dress Entrants must dress in accordance with GNAS rule 307. Archers must wear footwear that entirely encloses their feet, and may not wear Frayed, Camouflage, Olive Drab, or Denim Clothing.

Drug testing Record Status Shoots are subject to Drug Testing. If anybody is asked to provide a sample for drug testing and does not comply, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. A parent or guardian of every child entrant must consent to their child being tested by signing their entry form.

Photography In accordance with the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs at the event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival at the venue.

Please note SCAA intends to publish pictures taken at the event on their websites as previously, and encourage publication in archery magazines and elsewhere to help promote the Sport. Pictures published by SCAA will not be captioned in a way that identifies individuals unless the subjects have positively consented. By entering the tournament, participants (and / or their parents / guardians) confirm agreement to this policy. Local Newspapers and TV or Radio Stations may send reporters who may have different standards that SCAA cannot be held responsible for.

Data Protection opt-in By entering this competition, entrants affirm they agree to their personal details being used to compile the Entrants / Target lists and Results Sheets, which will be published and may be archived for posterity. Address and Contact information will not be shared with others, and will be kept in accordance with the SCAA Privacy Policy. Entrants also agree that address data may be held for up to 3 years and be used to publicise future archery events, but may opt-out of receiving publicity communications by contacting the Organiser and requesting removal from the list.

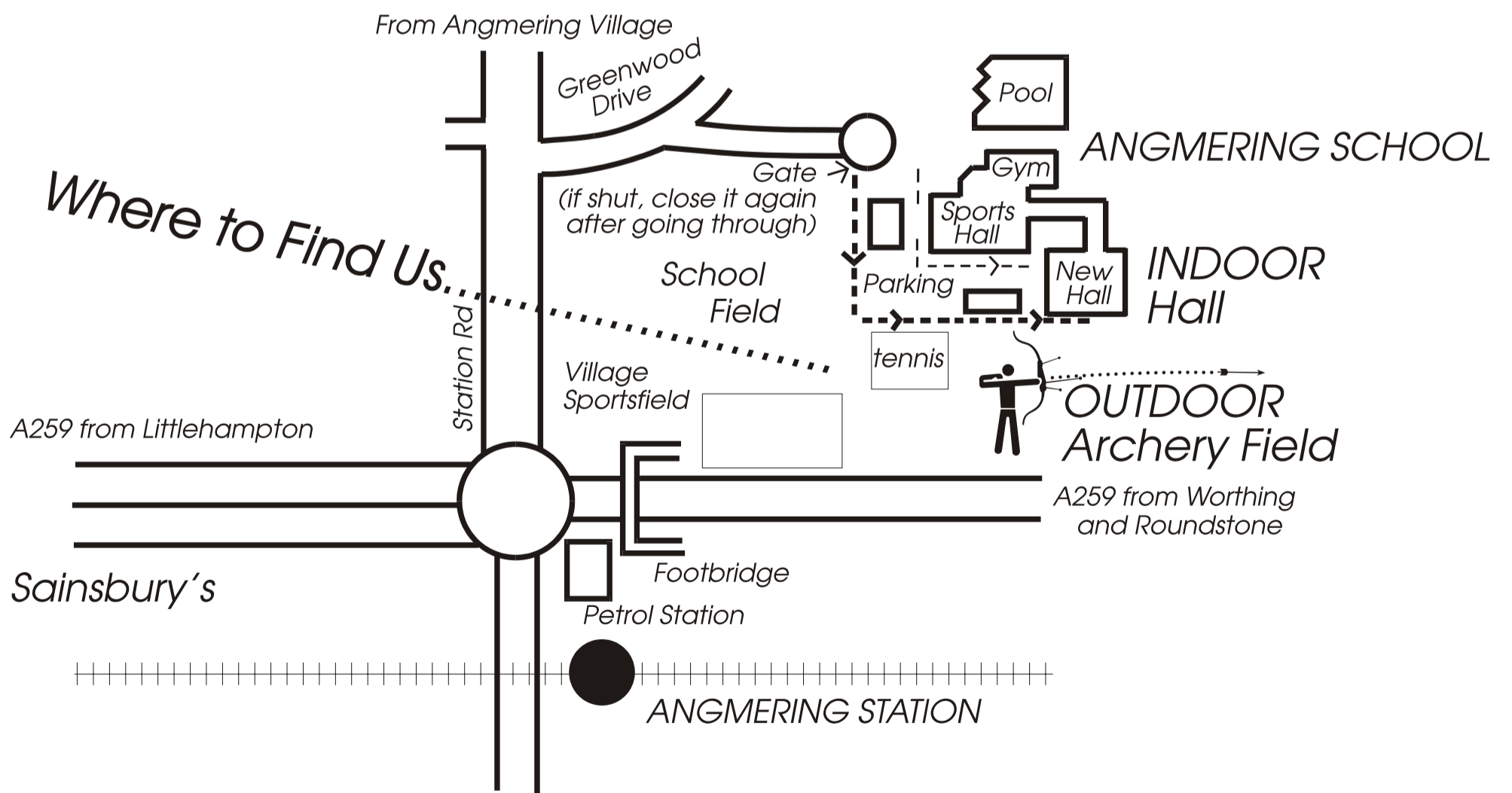
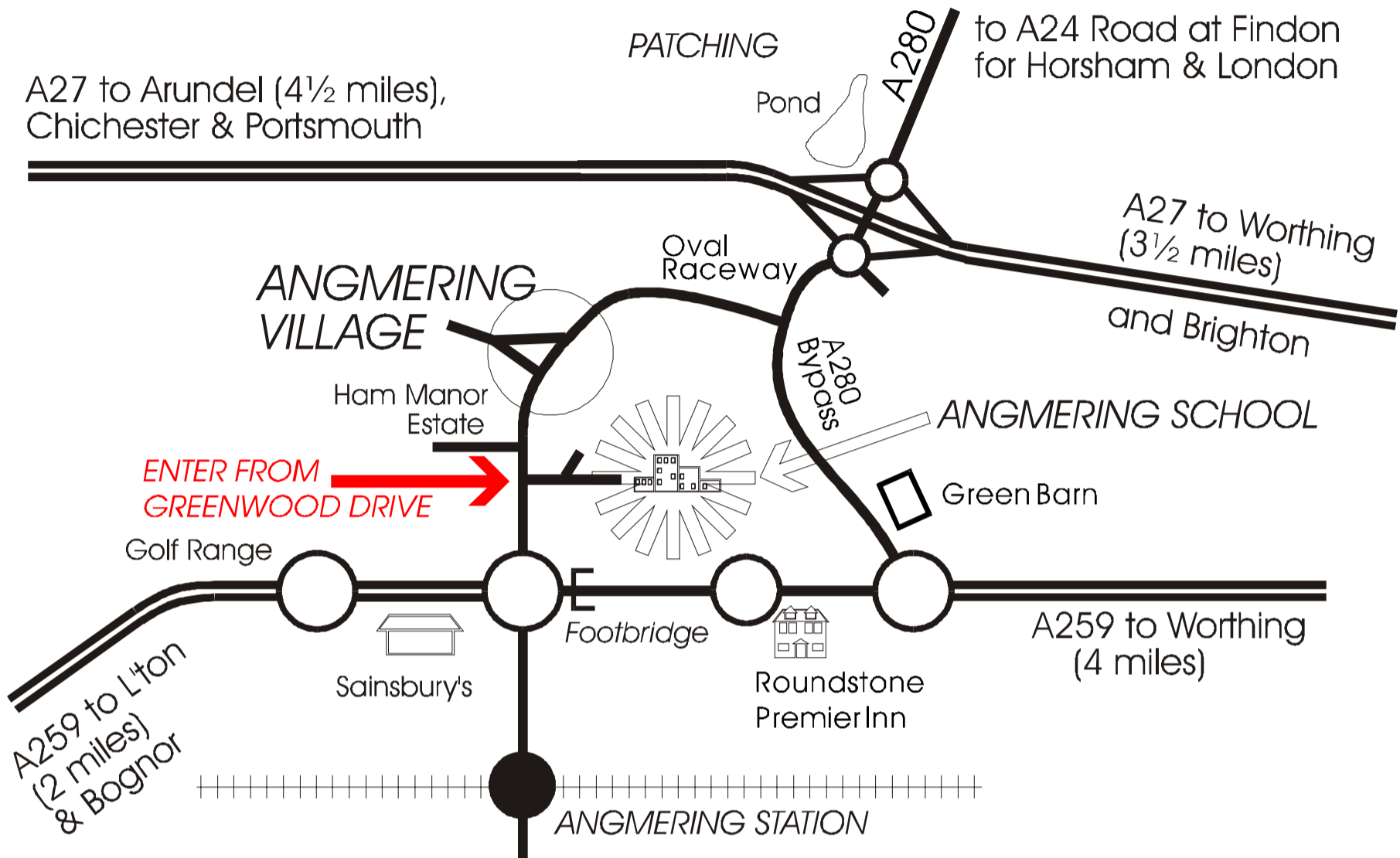
