Shoot details

Venue: The Holbrook Club, North Heath Lane, Horsham, West Sussex, RH12 5PJ.

Rounds: York, Hereford, Bristol I – V inclusive and Burntwood York for VI archers.

Entry fee: £8.50 seniors, £7 juniors. **Closing date:** 15th May, 2010. No refunds after this date.

Assembly: 9.30 am. **Sighters:** 9.45 am.

Timing of ends: ends of six arrows in two details of three, two and a half minutes allowed per detail. One whistle to commence shooting, two whistles to cease shooting.

Awards: team scores will comprise the best six scores (including both seniors and juniors) in each bow style. Medals will be awarded to the six members of each winning team. Medals will also be awarded to the best score by a visitor in each bow style.

Visitors: visitors are welcome to join us at this shoot, but priority will be given to entries received from Sussex archers until 24th April.

Arrows: the use of all carbon arrows is not permitted at this venue. All lost arrows must be located before the field is vacated.

Facilities: there is ample free parking on site. Refreshments, including cooked breakfast and lunch, will be available throughout the day.

Liability: Sussex County Archery Association, its members, The Holbrook Club, its members and staff cannot accept liability or responsibility for any loss or injury howsoever caused.

Rules of shooting: GNAS Rules of Shooting will apply.

Eligibility: this shoot is open to individuals affiliated to GNAS or a FITA member association. You must produce proof of membership for inspection if requested.

Dress code: plain white, plain dark green or your registered club colours (GNAS rule 307).

Drug testing: refusal to provide a sample for drug testing if requested will be treated as a positive result. A parent or guardian must consent to their child being tested by signing their entry form and explain the implications of drug testing to their child.

Photography: in accordance with the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival at the venue. Unauthorised photography or filming is prohibited.
