Falmer High School, Lewes Road, Brighton, BN1 9PW.

Double FITA 70 for adults and Junior Gents under 18

Double FITA 60, 50, 40m for juniors

Burntwood VIIR 1 for visually impaired

Single detail shoot – 4 archers per target – 2 archers per detail - line control by audible signals only, no lights.

The Double FITA 60, 50, 40 are special rounds for juniors of two 6 dozen rounds at 60m, 50m, 40m respectively according to age.

Burntwood for visually impaired archers

The Burntwood round was devised for visually handicapped archers, but offers a challenge without shooting long distances. All arrows are shot at a target set at 30metres distance, target faces are changed every 3 doz, starting with a 40cm size, and progressing through 60cm and 80cm to full 122cm face.

Juniors shooting the senior round will be eligible for junior awards only unless they pay the senior fee then they will be eligible for senior awards.
