



## **SUSSEX COUNTY ARCHERY ASSOCIATION THE SUSSEX LEAGUE (ALBION LEAGUE) 2018**

### **Change of League Name to The Sussex League**

Name change is to allow for any round to be adopted in the future.

**Round – Albion** – 3 dozen at 80 yards, 60 yards and 50 yards = 9 dozen in total on a 122cm face

Juniors are to shoot a Windsor specific for their age group at the same time the seniors shoot and will have their own league on an individual basis.

There is a separate longbow league on an individuals basis.

### **Scores**

Score adjustments are not being used.

### **Team format**

Comprising of five club members to include a minimum of one female or one junior shooting the same round:

- maximum of two compounds
- minimum of one barebow or traditional bow
- remaining team places to be comprised of recurves

### **Awards**

Trophy for the club which wins their respective division.

Ron and Doreen Cannon Challenge Trophy – to the second highest club score across the divisions, excluding division winners.

Trophy to the winner of the Longbow League.

Medals to the top three finishers in the Junior League for each distance.

### **Postal Option**

As Sussex is a large geographical area, the below will hopefully enable more clubs to participate from around the County.

By using the attached mileage working sheet, the visiting club will have the option to claim a postal round provided they are at least 45 miles from the hosting club and the hosting club agrees.

The round must be shot on the same day by agreement.

Notification of the decision must be emailed to the League Secretary before the round is shot.

## **SUSSEX COUNTY LEAGUE – TRAVEL TIMES**

1. Travel times are in hours and minutes, ie 1:20 equates to one hour and twenty minutes (online AA Route Planner used).
2. Where possible, the post code used is where each club shoots outdoors, as listed on their website and has been used for the start/end of journeys calculation.
3.  Journeys determined at 0:45 minutes or more. The clubs can decide whether to shoot the round on the same ground, or use the postal system and shoot the round at their respective home ground, provided the round is shot on the same day as their opponents. The League Secretary must be notified in advance.
