WA1440 – Shortest two distances – CUL & R/C use individual 6 zone 80cm / LB & BB use one 10 zone 80cm face (spaces limited)

Shooting will be to Chronotir timing system with archers shooting in two details AB & CD

Rules

World Archery Rules apply - All competitors must be a member of Archery GB or World Archery. Please present your card at registration.

Archery GB Dress Code (Rule 307) will apply – No Blue Denim or Camo

Parking
