Leagues	Albion League Windsor League Longbow League Junior League - as per distance pertaining to their age A club can nominate whether to shoot the Albion League or the Windsor League, or participate in both.
League Mission	Friendly meeting of clubs throughout Sussex.
Location	At a nominated match club ground within the clubs respective Division or Postal match shot on the same day, if the clubs agree, and if the clubs are 45 minutes apart. See travel time table below.
Rounds	Adults – Albion and/or Windsor dependent on which League the club enters Juniors – Short Junior Windsor as per age group: Windsor - any archer under the age of 18 years. Short Windsor - any archer under the age of 16 years. Junior Windsor - any archer under the age of 14 years. Short Junior Windsor - any archer under the age of 12 years.
Dates	Matches to be shot during the Summer outdoor season – April through to end of September
League Entry and Closing Date	Current (Albion) League members, new clubs to the Albion league, new clubs entering the Windsor league, Longbow League, Junior League - register your intention of joining one or any of the leagues by 29 th March 2019.

Club Organiser	Summer League representative at participating clubs. Each club must have a Summer League representative to contact the Summer League Organiser to advise of matches and match results.
League Formats	Albion and Windsor leagues - multiple divisions of 4 clubs or less per league, dependant on club numbers. Albion League – all clubs within their league (currently 3 per division) will shoot a match against all clubs in their league. Windsor League – for 2019 – clubs will shoot 3 rounds at their home club (or away at an Albion League match) and submit their achieved score. As no leagues have been established, the rounds will be based on a team league, which will be used as a basis for working out the Windsor leagues for the 2020 season. Longbow – individual league Juniors – individual league
Match Entry	It is the club organisers responsibility to contact other club organisers within their division to arrange match days.
Match Closing Date	All matches to be arranged during dates (above) and advised to the League Organiser by 30 th April

Match Timings	<p>Both clubs must arrange between them and shoot the same round(s) on the same day at the same location at one of their nominated club venues.</p> <p>If postal league, both clubs must shoot the round(s) on the same day.</p> <p>If arranging dates is an issue, then a 3-way shoot is permitted.</p> <p>All matches or cancelled matches must be notified to the Summer League Organiser.</p>
Match Format	<p>The league matches are meant to be a friendly meeting between clubs. It is recommended to build in a lunch or break during the day between distances. Sometimes, at the discretion of the host club, a post-match tea is held at the end of the round while the scores are compiled and for post match discussion.</p> <p>Hosting club organiser should liaise with visiting club organiser as to the shooting day format and facilities available.</p>
Scoring	Imperial 9-zone scoring on 122cm faces as per ArcheryGB rules.
League Points	<p>Win – 3points; Draw – 2 points; Loss 1 point.</p> <p>For a 'Did Not Show' or Cancellation, please see the rules on The Summer League website page at the Sussex County website.</p>
Team Format	<p>All club members may shoot either the Albion and/or Windsor round.</p> <p>Team of 4 to be selected per round:</p> <p>Maximum 2 compound</p> <p>Minimum 1 barebow</p> <p>Balance of archers to be recurve or barebow</p>
Submission of Scores	<p>After the match(es) are concluded, fill in the results score sheet to determine the winner of the round(s). This should be completed before either club leaves the ground and be signed by both Summer League Representatives.</p> <p>Result sheet copies are available at the website above.</p> <p>Send the score sheets to the Summer League Organiser by email (above) within one week of the match being shot.</p> <p>All scores to be submitted by 7th October.</p>
Awards	<p>Albion League – Albion League Trophy per division and medals for the winning teams.</p> <p>Albion League – Ron and Doreen Cannon Trophy for highest team score excluding winners of the Albion League</p> <p>Windsor League – Windsor League Trophy and medals to the winning team.</p> <p>Longbow League – Longbow Trophy and medal to the winner.</p> <p>Junior League – Medals to the winners of each Junior Round Distance</p>
